Subject: IRAQ Water Plant Report:

Arrival Date: Tuesday May 27th, 2003

Item # 1

Security Concerns; No perimeter security measures. Fence (mechanical) security down. Personnel Security minimal. Guards not containing / maintaining perimeter security.

Item # 2 Children and teenagers (males) on-site. (From 5 to 12 quantity)

Item # 3 Efforts to curtail unauthorized personnel, hampered by size of area to secure and easy access from all points. (N.S.E.W.)

Item # 4 Unauthorized on-lookers in work areas / when work being performed. Subject to - possible injury.

Item # 5 Compressed Gas Chlorine Cylinder Storage in Parking Area. Several cylinders with continual leakage from corroded valves. These were marked off with red danger tape.

Item # 6 Iraqi Elder advised to address children to stay away from Item # 5 Area. This was done. Children subject to fumes and vomiting or other exposure symptoms.

Item # 7 Munitions found in work area parking (driveway). US Military relocated same to a secure area which was cordoned off / marked. Iraqi Elder warned children of danger to approach this area.


Item # 8 Much loose Metal Sheeting (Debris) on-site. Some hanging from overhead, flimsily attached. Probable fly-off danger in windy conditions.

Item # 9 Many buildings / areas with trip - fall - cut - no lighting - residual chemicals hazards. These need to be secured from entry. And marked condemned / Do NOT Enter In Iraqi and English with Skull Symbols.

Item # 10 There is a pond with excess sulfur content. Unlined and poses an ecological concern.

Item # 11 Convoy (Unauthorized actions) Semi-Rig / Drivers
Convoy "Dropoffs" of personal items I.E: (T.V. set / Air Conditioning Unit) was seen during convoy trip. This poses security and other issues.

Item # 12 P.P.E. is needed: A supply list of P.P.E. was initiated by telephone to HSE - Kuwait to procure items necessary to work task assignments.

Item # 13 Night Shift Lighting

Problems with one Portable Light Plant providing light for welding operations. Continual breaker trips. From overheating? This was to be reported and corrected.

Item # 14 Minimal Flashlights on-site. Personnel walking from area to area in complete darkness. P.P.E. Items requested include flashlights and batteries.

Item # 15 No outdoors / indoors privy availability. Feces in areas of condemned buildings. These buildings are dangerous to enter – even to use for personal privacy measures. Especially at night in the dark!

Item # 16 Parking lot and driveways metal debris. A thorough clean up effort needs to be done to remove much debris which will puncture motor-vehicle tires.
